4.1 Welcome and Introductory Remarks by the Chairman

The Chairperson, Dr. J. Appa Rao, Principal, welcomed all members to the 4th Academic Council Meeting held on 15th October 2025 at 03.00 p.m. in the Conference Hall, TPO Cell.

The meeting was conducted in hybrid mode, with internal members attending physically and JNTUK nominees and external experts joining via Zoom.

The Chairman appreciated the members for their continued support and briefly outlined the key agenda.

Resolution: The Council noted the Chairman's welcome and introductory remarks.

4.2 Informing the Reconstitution of Academic Council

The Chairperson, informed the Council about the reconstitution of the Academic Council following recent administrative changes. Accordingly, Dr. M.H.M. Krishna Prasad, Director – Academic Planning (JNTUK), was included as a University Nominee, and Dr. K. Venkateswara Rao, Director, was added as an internal member. The Chairman welcomed the new members and expressed appreciation for their association with the institution.

Resolution: The Council approved the reconstitution of the Academic Council as presented.

4.3 Confirmation of Minutes of the Previous Academic Council Meeting

The Chairperson, presented the minutes of the 3rd Academic Council Meeting held on 6th May 2025 for confirmation. The Council reviewed the minutes and confirmed that all points were accurately recorded and circulated to the members after the previous meeting.

Resolution: The Council confirmed and approved the minutes of the 3rd Academic Council Meeting held on 06.05.2025.

4.4 Review of Action Taken on the Previous Meeting Held on 06.05.2025

The Chairperson presented the Action Taken Report (ATR) on the resolutions of the 3rd Academic Council Meeting held on 6th May 2025. The Council reviewed the report and noted that most of the decisions taken in the previous meeting have been effectively implemented.

The Chairman appreciated the efforts of all departments and coordinators and advised them to continue follow-up on pending activities related to syllabus implementation and ongoing accreditation processes.

Resolution: The Council reviewed and approved the Action Taken Report on the minutes of the 3rd Academic Council Meeting held on 06.05.2025.

4.5 Presentation of Student Admissions Status for A.Y. 2025–26

The Chairperson presented the AICTE Extension of Approval (EOA) for the Academic Year 2025–26, highlighting an increase in intake of 60 seats in CSE and 120 seats in CSE (AI&ML) compared to A.Y. 2024–25. He also presented the UG admission details, noting that the PG admission process is still in progress.

During the discussion, the Director of Academic Planning (DAP), JNTUK, enquired about the infrastructural readiness and faculty recruitment corresponding to the increased intake. The Chairman assured that all infrastructural requirements have been fulfilled, and additional faculty members have been appointed, ensuring that the Student–Faculty Ratio (SFR) is maintained as per AICTE norms.

Resolution: The Council reviewed and noted the Student Admission Status for A.Y. 2025–26 and appreciated the measures taken to meet AICTE requirements following the increased intake.

4.6 Review and Ratification of the Minutes of Board of Studies (BoS) Meetings

All the BoS Chairpersons explained the proceedings and key outcomes of their respective Board of Studies meetings, including discussions on approved Academic Regulations, course structures, and syllabi.

The Director of Academic Planning (DAP), JNTUK, reviewed the composition of the Boards of Studies (BoS) and advised that among the two subject experts from outside the parent university, at least one should preferably be from a Government University. He further suggested submitting a panel of four external subject experts, from which two will be ratified by the Academic Council. The DAP also emphasized that wherever a Government University nominee is not included, the reconstitution of the BoS should be carried out accordingly in the next BoS meeting, to ensure compliance with the prescribed composition guidelines.

The DAP also raised a few observations regarding the course structure and syllabus of M.Tech. – CSE (AI) under MR25 Regulations, and instructed the respective BoS Chairperson to submit a detailed justification addressing the concerns.

Resolution: The Council reviewed and ratified the minutes of all BoS meetings and endorsed the suggestions made by the DAP regarding BoS composition and syllabus justification.

4.7 Faculty Research Publications / Patents / R&D Projects

The Dean – R&D presented a report on the faculty research and innovation activities since the last Academic Council meeting. The presentation included details of research publications, patents, research projects, and students active participation in MSME IDEA Hackathons.

Resolution: The Council reviewed and noted the report and appreciated the faculty's continued efforts in promoting research, innovation, and project-based learning.

The detailed list of publications, patents, and projects is enclosed as **Annexure-E**.

4.8 Student Placement Details of the 2025 Passed-Out Batch

The Training and Placement Officer (TPO) presented the placement statistics of the 2025 passed-out students and provided a comparative analysis with the previous two years.

Resolution: The Council reviewed and noted the placement report and appreciated the efforts of the TPO and placement team.

The detailed placement data and comparative analysis are enclosed as **Annexure-F**.

4.9 Review and Ratification of Examination Results

The Controller of Examinations (CoE) explained the minutes of the 6th, 7th, and 8th Results Committee Meetings and presented the Academic Results – II Semester – A.Y. 2024-25 for all UG and PG programs. A comparative analysis with the results of the previous two batches was also presented to the Council.

4.10 Approval for Issue of Degree of 2023 Admitted PG Students (Phase-I)

The Controller of Examinations (CoE) presented the design of the Provisional Certificate for PG programs, which was prepared in accordance with the guidelines of JNTUK. The members reviewed and ratified the design as presented.

The CoE also presented the consolidated list of students eligible for the award of degrees of 2023 Admitted PG Students, mentioning that all data and records were prepared as per the guidelines of the Director of Evaluation (DE), JNTUK. It was further informed that the eligibility list will be submitted to the DE office for approval of the Provisional Certificates (PCs).

Detailed information of degree-eligible students, prepared in line with JNTUK guidelines, was also presented to the Council for review.

Resolution: The Council reviewed and approved the design of the PG Provisional Certificate and ratified the list of eligible students for the degree 2024–25.

4.11 Accreditations & Achievements

The Chairperson informed the Council that the one-day NBA visit for data verification pertaining to the Compliance Reports was successfully completed on 27th September 2025 (Saturday) for two UG programs — B.Tech. in Computer Science and Engineering and B.Tech. in Electronics and Communication Engineering.

The Chairman also presented the notable achievements of students and faculty, including awards, recognitions, and research publications. Details of the Induction Program conducted for the 2025-admitted students were also shared with the members.

It was further informed that an NCC Sub-Unit (22(A) BN) has been successfully established in the institution to promote discipline, leadership, and national service among students.

Resolution: The Council noted the successful completion of the NBA data verification visit and appreciated the achievements of students and faculty, the conduct of the induction program, and the establishment of the NCC Sub-Unit.

4.12 Any Other Items with the Permission of the Chair

Mr. Srinivasa Ramanujam, Delivery Head, Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), expressed his willingness to extend continuous support in arranging industry experts for Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) and other industry-related initiatives. He assured the Council of his cooperation

in strengthening the academia–industry collaboration and contributing to the institution’s professional development activities.

Resolution: The Council noted and appreciated the continued support and collaboration extended by TCS towards academic and industry integration.

The meeting concluded with a Vote of Thanks proposed by the Member Secretary, expressing gratitude to the Chairperson, JNTUK nominees, external experts, and all members for their active participation and valuable contributions.
